PLAYERS CONTRACT

The players of the Spryfield Junior Hockey Club must adhere to all club policies and guidelines below.

- 1. A team dress code has been implemented all players and coaching staff must wear a collared shirt, dress pants, casual shoes. When available, players and staff will wear our track suits to all away games;
- 2. Players and coaches must be at the rink one hour prior to games. If for any reason you are unable to attend or to arrive at the rink one hour prior to game time, you must notify the coaching staff in advance. Be dressed and ready to play at least 10 minutes before game time for coach's pregame talk:
- 3. Under age restrictions are enforced in reference to alcohol and tobacco usage;
- 4. Travel expenses and accommodations will be provided by the team while on the road for overnight trips (hotel and gas). When possible, one team meal will be provided.
- 5. Each player must pay a registration fee of \$400. \$200 is due by Oct. 15^{TH.} The balance of \$200 by Nov. 25TH This can be paid personally or by sponsors. Sponsor money is not refundable nor prorated.
- 6. Players are required to participate in all team fundraisers;
- 7. Team merchandise belongs to the team and must be returned upon being released from the team or at year end.
- 8. Stick tape, shin pad tape, visor spray, socks, jerseys and skate sharpening (home games) will be provided by the team.
- 9. Players must be present for a minimum of 75% of the assigned practices. If this mandate is not met coaching staff will conduct a review. Failure to attend 75% of practices or to notify the coach when you cannot make it may result in discipline; including, but not limited to suspension or dismissal.
- 01. Curfew at away games will be at the coach's discretion and followed without excuse;
- 11. Players will be held accountable for any damage of property (i.e. Rinks, hotels and vehicles) that is a result of the player's actions;
- 12. Players must wear full and proper gear during all on ice sessions including practice and warm up. This includes neck protectors, mouth guards and chin straps done up;
- 13. Discipline of the team will be administered by the coaching staff should a player be in breach of any of the rules on this contract and/or any provincial or criminal offense. _____, agree to all the terms and conditions as outlined in this contract.
